Lock 'N Load/DVG Counter Tray Dividers v1.0

Page 2: 21 tray dividers (3 per column, 7 columns per page) for the deep-dish counter trays from Lock 'N Load Publishing and DVG. Print one sheet per tray that you need dividers for, and you'll have one extra in case you mess up any of the others.

Instructions

Step 1: Cut along exterior red and grey lines, red along the long side of the page and grey at the top and bottom.

Step 2: Perforate/Score along the **BLUE** lines.

Step 3: Cut along RED lines.

Step 4: Cut along GREEN lines.

Step 5: Glue or use double-sided tape the two middle sections of each divider. These sections are labeled A and B in the top left corner divider, for reference.

Step 6: Fold so that "A" section meets "B" section. Allow to dry if using glue.

Step 7: Trim corners as needed to fit into tray.

Step 8: Organize your counters for easy retrieval, meaning you can get your games to the table faster! Enjoy!

Notes

I have found that trimming each individual counter once it is cut from the sheet, and before folded/glued works best.

Each divider will hold 10, ¾" x 2mm size counters, which is what you have in both Nations at War and World at War 85 from Lock 'N Load Publishing. Approximately 3-4 more counters can be stored to the side of each divider, along-side the stack of 10 counters. This allows up to 28 counters to be organized per well.

When printing, be sure to select None for scaling. Do not Reduce to Printer Margins in your printer settings.
